

The Nathaniel Roger's family bible contains the birth, death, and marriage records of his children and he and his wife. It came into possession of Lucy K. Rogers Stiles (daughter of Nathaniel) of Elmira, N.Y. where it was copied and the data furnished to Edith Rogers Johnson (grand daughter of Earliman Rogers who was Nathaniel's son) by Fanny E. Rogers Utley (daughter of Jesse F. Rogers 2nd the son of Nathaniel) of Alden, Iowa. Data is contained in letter from Fanny E. (Rogers) Utley dated 14 October 1903 to Edith Rogers Johnson. Copy attached the original is in the possession of the applicant.

Note bible data indicates that Earliman Rogers was the son of Nathaniel Rogers and Phebe Fuller

Dear cousin

Your letter of Aug 16th was forwarded to Spokane, where we were visiting a niece of mine, Sister Fidelias oldest daughter. I sent you a postal, saying I would write you when we returned home, and give you all the information in my possession in regard to our family. We have the family record that we copied from a bible at Aunt Lucy's once when we were visiting her, and I will copy it and send to you. I think ^{it} will be some help to you. We returned home Sept-25th and were away eight weeks lacking one day. We first ~~first~~ visited the most wonderful place in the

world, that is, Yellowstone Park. We were in the Park five and a half days, and we enjoyed it very much. We think if we live and have our health we will go there again some day. We went west as far as Portland Oregon stopping several times on the way to visit friends, and see the sights. We traveled about 5,000 miles, and saw many interesting things. We expect now to start for California about Dec first. My sister Helen and her oldest daughter Nellie, are going with us, also your aunt Sarah Rogers. We expect to spend the winter there. You ask about your Uncle Carl's boys. Carl lives on the farm my father used to own about 3/4 of a mile from town. Lyman lives here in town and is clerking in our store. Frank as you know, was married last June and is living at Fort Dodge. He is engineer on the Ill Central R.R. His mother is there now for a couple of weeks. Remember us kindly to your people.
